Subject: Policies and guidelines for pregnant otho staff

- Q1 Does your occupational health department have any departmental guidelines relating to pregnant staff who work in theatre in order to protect the health of the mother and baby from radiation and other harmful substances?
- A1 The Trust has a maternity policy which includes risk assessment of pregnant women, wherever they work and includes referral to Occupational Health if required.

- A2 The Freedom of Information Act gives rights of public access to information held by public authorities, this right covers all recorded information held by a public authority, the Act doesn't however confer any explicit right to copies of original documents.

- Q3 Does your theatre department have any department-specific guidelines for pregnant staff who work in theatre in order to protect the health of the mother and baby from radiation and other harmful substances?
