Subject: Completed capital construction projects within the last 5 years?

- Q1 Has the Trust undertaken and completed any capital construction projects within the last 5 years?
- A1 Yes, the following capital projects were completed in the last 5years.
 - Alder Centre in 2020
 - Institute Phase 2 August 2018
 - Springfield Park Phase 1 2021
 - Old Hospital demolition and clearance 2021
 - ED Urgent treatment centre Jan 2023
- Q2 If yes, was a post occupancy evaluation (POE) study carried out after the project's completion?
- A2 No
- Q3 If no, what were the reasons for not carrying out a POE?
- A3 Alder Hey Children's hospital was rebuilt 7 years ago and has followed two years of post-construction works. A POE was started but has never been completed due to the size of the task, costs, insufficient resources and the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic.

We have, however, recently agreed a new Capital Management Policy which commits to undertaking POEs and this will apply to buildings opening in 2023.
