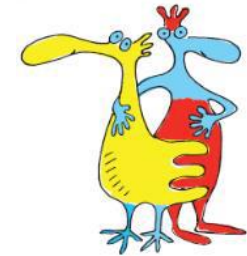

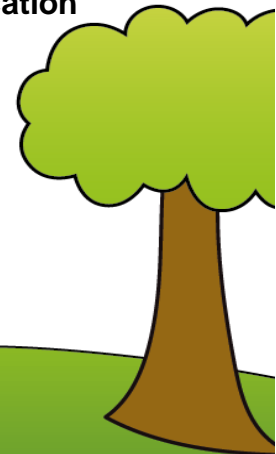

• take off your t-shirt or your shoes



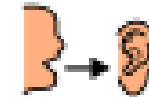
• move your arms or legs, if you can



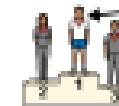
