Q1 Please can you provide the number of physical assaults against hospital staff by patients and members of the public on the Trusts premises for the following five years: 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023?

- Physical Abuse incidents (patient on staff) – 78
 - Physical Abuse incident (Public / visitor on staff) – 3
- 2020
- Physical Abuse incidents (patient on staff) – 58
 - Physical Abuse incident (Public / visitor on staff) – 3
- 2021
- Physical Abuse incidents (patient on staff) – 43
 - Physical Abuse incident (Public / visitor on staff) – 1
- 2022
- Physical Abuse incidents (patient on staff) – 28
 - Physical Abuse incident (Public / visitor on staff) – 5
- 2023
- Physical Abuse incidents (patient on staff) – 67
 - Physical Abuse incident (Public / visitor on staff) – 4

Total Physical Abuse incidents (patient on staff) over a 5 year period is 271, with a further 16 incidents recorded of Physical Abuse incidents (Public / visitor on staff)

Q2 How many of these physical assaults were reported to the police for the following five years: 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023?

A4 Yes. Over the last few years we have introduced anti bite gloves, spit guards, body-worn cameras and more intensive and specific training for security and staff.
